

LPOne Concerts: How to Listen

Not sure how to listen to our online concerts?

We'll be sharing our favourite recordings of works from our cancelled concerts as playlists on Spotify and IDAGIO. But don't worry – you can listen directly from our website provided you have an internet connection and a Spotify or IDAGIO user account.

If you already have either a Spotify or an IDAGIO account you just need to make sure you're logged in on whatever device you're using.

If you do not yet have an account, both services offer a free version (you will hear occasional advertising messages between tracks), so all you need to do is to sign up to your preferred service with your email address.

If you prefer to listen ad-free, both Spotify and IDAGIO also offer a paid-for premium service without advertising, which includes advanced features like the ability to listen offline and create your own playlists. It is often possible to have a free trial of the premium services, however it is not necessary to have a premium account to listen to our playlists. Please note though, that on mobile devices the free Spotify service will shuffle playlist tracks – this is not the case with the desktop version.
